Utility Rate Change

The monthly garbage collection rate increased by \$2.50 as of July 1st, 2018. This increase was already charged on the July utility billing.

Cannabis seems to be in everyone's conversation and news story these days. As a Municipality, Rosemary is required to incorporate "cannabis" into several bylaws by October 19, 2018, when recreational use becomes legalized. Council is considering creating a "Smoking Bylaw" that will see the consumption/smoking of cannabis & tobacco not allowed in all public places, including roads & sidewalks, to align with the legislation on alcohol. This would mean that residents & their guest would be allowed to smoke or consume tobacco & cannabis products on their private property but no where else in Rosemary, unless council approved a designated "smoking" area.
