Merry Christmas & Happy New Year

Rural Crime Watch organized a presentation in Rosemary and identified areas where residents could be more vigilant:

- ◆ **Keep doorways & windows visible by removing or pruning shrubs & trees; install good locks & put away ladders**
- ◆ **Keep valuables like cash, keys, & wallets out of plain view or lock up**
- ◆ **Don't post your trip or intention to take a trip on social media—wait until you get home to post**
- ◆ **Ensure your house number is clearly posted for Emergency, Fire, & Police**
- ◆ **And if you see anything suspicious please report to police; then post to social media if you wish. Check out @BrooksandDistrictRuralCrimeWatch on Facebooks & Messenger.**
- **Snow Removal** *As outlined in Bylaw 419/10, "A person shall clear away any snow, ice, dirt, or other obstruction within (24) twenty-four hours after the time*

of snow, ice, dirt, or other obstruction was deposited or formed on the sidewalk."

- **Electrical Cords** *Also outlined in Bylaw 419/10, an electrical cord over a sidewalk must be suspended 2.5 meters above the sidewalk to ensure safe passage of pedestrians.*
- **Overdue Property Taxes** *Any outstanding property taxes will be charged an 18% penalty on Jan 1/19.*
- **Cottonwood Crescent Lots** *are still available for \$1,000 each!*
