Weekly Garbage Pickup: All garage **MUST** be bagged and must fit into your bin with the lid closed! Several items that should not be placed in your bin are: paint, dead animals, batteries, used oil, chemicals, rocks, dirt, or appliances. Please roll your bin back into your yard Tuesday evening.

Weed Management: Public Works will be actively spraying for weeds. Please watch for notices in the affected areas.

Compost: There is compost available for pick up at the Newell Recycling Station in Brooks at no charge. Address: 279 Veiner Road, Brooks

Boulevards: Just a reminder that maintaining & mowing boulevards is the responsibility of the adjacent land owner. Some boulevards are between the sidewalk & curb, and some are between the sidewalk and your lot line.

Pools: All pools deeper than 24” are required to meet provincial building code guidelines. Please drop by the office for more details.

REMEMBER — Keep front & back yards and boulevards clean.

-- Please roll your garbage bins back into your yard Tuesday evening.

-- All Dogs need to be licensed at the Village Office for a one time cost of \$20.00 per animal AND **kept on a leash at all times outside of your yard**. Max of 3 dogs per household allowed or 2 if any is a restricted breed.
