Fire Prevention Week Oct 9-15th, 2022

Today's homes burn faster than ever. You may have as little as two minutes to safely escape a home from the time the smoke alarm sounds. Your ability to get out of a home during a fire depends on early warning from a smoke alarm and advance planning.

The Fire Department encourages everyone to embrace the 2022 Fire Prevention Week theme:

"Fire won't wait, plan your escape."

Key Home and fire escape tips:

- Make sure your plan meets the need of all your household members
- Smoke alarms should be installed in every sleeping room, outside each sleeping area and each level of your home.
- Know at least two ways out of every room(if possible), make sure all doors and windows open easily.
- Have an outside meeting place a safe distance from your home where everyone should meet

Practice your home fire drill at least twice a year, practice once during the day and once at night.

REMEMBER: To keep yard clean & boulevards weed free. Please remove non-operative vehicles and garbage from your property. Roll your garbage bins back into your yard Tuesday evening.

<u>Dogs</u> need to be licensed through the Village Office at a onetime cost of \$40.00 per animal AND <u>always kept</u> on a leash outside your yard. There is a maximum of three dogs per household unless there is a restricted dog, then only two dogs are permitted.

<u>Winter RV Parking</u> Available for free in the Rosemary Campground. RV's & trailers must be off the boulevards by October 15th. Please contact the office for more details.
